

Book Sandwich

**YOU MUST NOT CHOOSE A BOOK THAT IS ALSO A MOVIE. IT IS YOUR JOB TO MAKE SURE YOUR BOOK ISN'T A MOVIE.
I WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY BOOK SANDWICHES THAT ARE ALSO MOVIES.
CHECK WITH ME BEFORE YOU SETTLE ON A BOOK.**

Directions: There are nine (9) sheets of colored paper, and you will place the following information on each sheet. You must supply your own paper. You must label each sheet (characters, themes, conflict, etc).

- **Cream-colored (or brown) sheet (bread)** – Write the **title, author, and your name** on it. This will be the cover of your report.
- **Green colored sheet (pickles)** – Two **Themes** in the book. Make sure you fully explain why or how it is a theme. ***YOU NEED TO INCLUDE DIRECT QUOTES FROM THE BOOK WITH PAGE NUMBERS AS SPECIFIC EXAMPLES. Explain your examples.***
- **White/Purple colored sheet (onions)** – **Setting** (place and time) If there is more than one, include all of the main ones. Describe the setting in detail. ***YOU NEED TO INCLUDE DIRECT QUOTES FROM THE BOOK WITH PAGE NUMBERS AS SPECIFIC EXAMPLES. Explain your examples.***
- **Green colored sheet (green pepper)** – At least two **Conflicts**. What are they and how are they solved? Each conflict will answer three questions: What is the conflict?; What type of conflict is it? (Person vs person; person vs nature; person vs self; etc); and How is the conflict solved? ***YOU NEED TO INCLUDE DIRECT QUOTES FROM THE BOOK WITH PAGE NUMBERS AS SPECIFIC EXAMPLES. Explain your examples.***
- **Red colored sheet (tomato)** – Two **Characters** – One character you will relate to your own life. How is the character most like you? ***Use three specific examples to support your claims.*** You will simply describe the second character. Describe them physically as well as their personalities. Explain any changes in both characters. ***Use direct quotes and page numbers to help you.***
- **Green colored sheet (lettuce)** – Explain the **connections** to your life. (at least three) ***Provide direct quotes and page numbers*** and be sure to explain how it is a connection.
- **Yellow/Orange colored sheet (cheese)** – **Climax**. What is the highest point of intensity/excitement in the story – the point where the ending becomes clear? (1 Paragraph (4-7 sentence) explanation)
- **Pink colored sheet (Ham)** – Provide a brief (2 paragraph (4-7 sentences each)) summary of your novel.
- **Cream-colored (or brown) sheet (bread)** – Respond to the novel. Explain your thoughts. Feelings, impressions, etc. about the novel. Did you enjoy the book? Why or why not? Who else would enjoy this novel? This must be at least two solid paragraphs (4-7 sentences per paragraph).
- **Extra pages** – You may also include other ingredients where you might include favorite passages, vocab terms, etc. (each extra page will grant you 3 extra credit points (up to 9)).

*** The pages must be **NEAT**. Pages must be typed.
