Pastels are made of powdered pigments and are similar to oil paints, except they are dry. A famous artist is Michelangelo Buonarotti (1475-1564). He was famous for creating more than ninety chalk-and-ink works.

A third technique is sculpting. A very famous sculptor is Donatello (1386-1466). He lived in the Renaissance period and was a master in sculpting with bronze, wood, and stone. Creations in the sculpting category include pottery, jewelry, and mosaics. Pottery is made by molding clay into a desired shape and putting it into a kiln, which hardens the clay. A mosaic is formed by putting together small pieces of colored glass or stone to create a bigger picture. It is usually used for decoration.

The final popular medium in art is photography. The pictures can show amazing aspects of the world at different angles. Photographers can also use different lenses and settings to get an even better picture. Photoshop is also a part of photography. People may use this to enhance and edit their photos to make them more appealing to look at. A very popular photographer is Ansel Adams (1902-1984).
